After logging in with your login parameters, click on "New Submission" and follow the recommended steps. Please enter the following text in "Comments for the Editor" in step 1: 28th International Conference "Noise and Vibration".

The paper must be written in English and should not exceed 12 pages, including figures, tables, references and illustrations. In the attachment, you can find the instructions for paper preparation.

The word file may be saved as a .doc or .docx file. Please note that equations must be editable, i.e. they cannot be given as figures.

The deadline for article submission is September 1, 2024.
