Who can apply?

- Students, researchers, academic and administrative staff from universities in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, Montenegro, and Serbia (Target group 1, 2 or 3).
- Students, researchers, academic and administrative staff from partner universities in the EU (Target group 1).
- Applicants must have finished at least one year of university studies.
- Applicants from the Western Balkans cannot have spent more than a total of 12 months over the last 5 years in one of the EU countries (doesn't apply to TG3 and Staff).

Target group 1

Students, researchers, academic and administrative staff registered at one of the Western Balkan or EU partner universities. Applies to: undergraduate, master, doctoral students, post doctorate, academic and administrative staff.

Target group 2

Nationals of one of the eligible Western Balkan countries registered in a higher education institution not included in the SIGMA consortium. Applies to: master and doctoral students, post doctorate and staff.

Target group 3

Nationals of one of the Western Balkan countries in particularly vulnerable situations, e.g. for political or social reasons. Applies to: undergraduate, master and doctoral students.

Duration of the scholarships

Undergraduates 1 – 2 semesters

Masters 1 – 4 semesters

Doctorates 1 – 6 semesters

Post-doctorates 6 months

Academic and administrative staff 1 month
